

HANDLING FEES FOR IMAGE SERVICE

Many images managed by the Museums of World Culture are published under Public Domain (copyright expired) or under Creative Commons Attribution, such as CC BY. We are working towards full open licensing and have begun to publish free images in high-resolution via Wikimedia Commons. If the image you are looking for is not available in high-resolution on Wikimedia Commons, you can order images through our image service with a handling fee.

HIGH-RESOLUTION IMAGES

500 SEK/image

If high resolution images are available, the first five copies will be delivered free of charge to:

- Researchers
- Non-commercial academic publishers
- Official representatives for Indigenous peoples.

The pictures are delivered in Tiff format.

NOTE: a fee of 200 SEK is added to images that require scanning.

PICTURE SEARCH / RESEARCH BY AGREEMENT

500 SEK / hr.

PHOTOGRAPHY OF OBJECT

Hourly fee (minimum charge 2 hours) 800 SEK.

RETOUCHING BY AGREEMENT

700 SEK / image.

We request that reference copies of the publication where images managed by the World Cultural Museums are used be sent to us, both printed matters and links to or screenshots of online-publications.

According to Swedish law (1978:800) governing the use of images for commercial purposes, where persons are recognizable in said images, the persons depicted must give their consent before publication. The responsibility to obtain such consent lies with the publisher of the image(s).

Otherwise, refer to the Copyright Act on Literary and Artistic Works (1960: 729, 2005: 359, 2005: 360, 2011: 94) and the Personal Data Act (1998: 204, 2006: 398). The EU's new data protection regulation will be applied from 2018.
